2 Divisions

PCL 14 (Intermediate) and PCL 18 (Advanced), separated by DUPR rating to ensure competitive fairness.



2-Day Format

Saturday pool play, Sunday playoffs and finals. Every club guaranteed 3 matches on Day 1.



MiLP-Style Matches

2 mixed doubles, 1 men's doubles, 1 women's doubles per match. Full team on court every matchup.
